KIDDIE KAMPUS

Students will assist the Pre-K teachers through their day which includes: circle time, project time, movement, free play, snack, lunch, rest period, fine motor and outdoor play (weather permitting). The students will learn the dedication, organizational skills and structure that are required to provide a safe and educational environment for Pre-K students in a full day setting.

LITTLE ANGELS CENTER

Students will go through a typical day as a speech pathologist, occupational & physical therapist.
