Dante Scholarship

Sponsored by: The Dante Foundation

The Dante Foundation is a nonprofit organization founded to foster Italo-American heritage and culture through education and philanthropic endeavors.

Criteria: Seniors of Italo-American ancestry who will be attending an accredited college or university. They are seeking students who have achieved high standards in academics, extracurricular activities and scored above average on the SAT exam.

Award: Several \$5000.00 scholarships

Each high school is only permitted to send in four applications, any students interested should see their counselor as soon as possible. If more than four students apply, a scholarship committee will determine which four students will be able to apply for the scholarship.

Robert G. Porter Scholars Program

Criteria: Applicant must be an AFT member's dependent and parent or guardian must be an AFT member for at least one year. An essay, transcript, and letters of recommendation must be submitted.
