Student's Name

Students who participate in either the Senior Banquet or Junior Prom should recognize that they have an obligation to themselves, their classmates, and the school community to act maturely and responsibly. Participation in either event is a privilege. It should be a positive experience where students exhibit civil behavior, respect for others, and mature judgment.

The following are expectations for **all** attendees (Please note that any outside guest must complete and turn in an "**Outside Banquet / Prom Guest Application**" with this contract):

Students and guests attending the banquet or prom must:

- 1) Understand that participation in banquet/prom activities is a privilege and should be valued.
- 2) Understand and abide by the rules and regulations that govern all school activities. Respect for others is paramount. This includes respect for the supervisors and staff of the school and catering hall, as well as classmates.
- 3) Use appropriate language and refrain from crude or abusive language or gestures when dealing with administrators, supervisors, and classmates.
- 4) Understand that they may not be under the influence of, *or in possession of*, any intoxicating beverage, drugs, narcotic, or controlled substance. This applies to all individuals regardless of age. Violation of this rule will result in a five-day home suspension and loss of other privileges. In addition, parents will be contacted and be required to pick up and transport their child home.
- 5) Refrain from being disorderly, disruptive, or insubordinate, and be responsible for their behaviors. Therefore, students who are found in violation of the student code of conduct and/or this contract will face disciplinary consequences. In addition, parents will be contacted and be required to pick up and transport their child home.
- 6) Understand that once at the venue, students may not leave the location and later re-enter the event.
- 7) Understand that this contract is also an emergency contact sheet and must be completed and turned in **before** purchasing a banquet or prom ticket.

In the event that an individual does not meet the expectations of school administration and this contract, that student will be removed from the event. Parents will be notified and be required to transport their child home. No refunds will be issued.
