Payment will be accepted in cash or check made out to Bayport-Blue Point UFSD. Include your phone number on your check. Any returned check handling fees will be charged back to enrollees.

District residents 60 years of age and older will receive a 10% fee discount (except materials fee). Please register in person at our Administrative Center and bring proof of age and residency.

All enrollment is on a first-come, first-served basis. Minimum enrollment will be required to hold some classes. No refunds will be given unless a course must be cancelled due to insufficient registration. We reserve the right to modify course hours or sessions as needed to maintain self-sustaining guidelines (with the original fee). In such cases, students will be informed of available options. **There will be no make-up classes for classes cancelled due to inclement weather or district closures during the Winter 2011 session. (Exception: 6-hour Defensive Driving course - make-up classes provided for completion of NYS approved program)**

To: Administrative Offices, 189 Academy Street, Bayport, NY 11705 *and*
Bayport-Blue Point High School, 200 Snedecor Avenue, Bayport, NY 11705

Nicolls Road South to end (Montauk Hwy.) Bear right onto Montauk Hwy. Travel (3) lights to Snedecor Avenue. Make left turn. Cross railroad tracks. Immediate right turn onto Railroad Avenue brings you to North Parking Lot and entrance to high school.

For the Administrative Center, cross railroad tracks and continue south on Snedecor past the high school to the Stop sign on the corner - Academy Street. Make a right turn and another right turn into the South parking lot of the high school. The Administrative Center is a brick extension off the back of the high school to your left.

To: Blue Point Elementary School, 212 Blue Point Avenue, Blue Point, NY 11715

Nicolls Road South to end (Montauk Hwy.) Bear left onto Montauk Hwy. Make right turn onto Blue Point Avenue. Travel approx. a half-mile. School is on your right (across the street from the Blue Point Fire Dept.).

To: JWY Middle School, 602 Sylvan Avenue, Bayport, NY 11705

Nicolls Road South to Purick Street (exit on right side of road). Make right onto Purick and travel to end (stop sign). You will be on the corner of Sylvan Avenue and Purick Street. Directly across is a sign indicating the school and entrance to the parking lot. Cross Sylvan and take driveway to parking lot. The middle school is the round, red brick building on your right.
